PLANNING A HOME IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Please be reminded that if you are doing any kind of exterior projects to your home or landscape all residents are to comply with Cedar Creek Covenants, which requires each resident to submit to the Homes Association Office a "Modification" form. Projects include, tree trimming and exterior painting as well as landscape, driveway or sidewalk, patio, or deck changes. Once the appropriate form has been completed and turned into the HOA Office, the "Modification Committee" has 30 DAYS to review and notify you of their decision. **NO WORK IS TO BE DONE PRIOR TO APPROVAL.** These forms can be obtained on the eNeighbors page under "Resources" or at the HOA Office located in the Swim and Racquet Clubhouse. 2011 RESIDENT AND GUEST TAGS AVAILABLE

New tags for the calendar year, 2011 are now available at the Swim and Racquet Clubhouse. Please complete the form that is provided in this newsletter and return to the HOA Office in the Swim and Racquet Clubhouse to obtain your new tags. Resident tags will again be "free" to all residents living in your home however; if they are lost there will be a charge of \$5.00 per tag to replace. Also, guest tags will again be \$5.00 and each household can purchase a total of (4). Please remember that tags are required for the use of ALL Cedar Creek Amenities.

You should have received your dues statements by this time along with several items for your review regarding payment options. If you have NOT received your statement please contact the HOA Office as soon as possible to

avoid any "late fees." An explanation of your dues was also provided for your information.

NEW HEATING AND A/C UNITS AT THE SWIM AND RACQUET CLUB

We want to keep you informed of significant repairs and improvements here in Cedar Creek. The units that have serviced the gymnasium are the original units and are in need of replacement. The scope of this replacement project consists of removal of the old units that were originally installed on the roof of the gym. These two units will be replaced by a larger more efficient single unit and placed on a concrete slab in the rear of the clubhouse. Once the new unit is installed there will be a screening structured built to match the existing exterior of the clubhouse building. This will serve to conceal the unit as well as minimize the sound when operating. We also are adding support beams in the gymnasium due to some wood rot issues.

Finance Committee – Jim Tiehen

Through the end of November we are right at budget. Jim reported that the water expense for some of the neighborhoods is over budget for the year. A hot summer and dry fall contributed to the need for additional watering which caused higher water bills and sprinklers to be used into November. Also, additional watering was needed on the areas that were converted from buffalo grass to fescue. Overall we are in great shape.

The Board has authorized the HOA to have a professional “reserve study” completed on all of the common area assets for Service Corp. An article was passed out to provide the reps with information as to what a “reserve study” is for and why you might want it done. Jim informed the reps that if they want to have one

completed for their neighborhood, please notify Glenda before the end of the year. Costs run from \$400 to \$600 per neighborhood and would be paid for out of your neighborhood budget.

Management – Jim Tiehen

The 2011 dues statements will be mailed out this week. We worked hard to keep the dues the same as last year. Some neighborhoods are having special projects done so they will see an increase but overall dues remained about the same.

Dues can be paid by monthly automatic withdrawal, online through Pronto pay with your credit card or by check. The budget for 2011 includes approximately \$100,000 in capital improvements, \$40,000 in landscape renovations and \$55,000 put in a reserve fund. Major Capital projects are: security cameras at the pools; conver-

sion of pools to salt water; pool furniture; pool heaters; resurface the tennis courts as well as continue to look into what can be done with the SG Park and pond area.

Overall we have done a good job on collecting delinquent dues. We are currently at less than 1% or nine residents delinquent. We feel we can still collect on three but will probably not be able to collect on six due to foreclosure and bankruptcy.

There is a new Kansas Act that will go into effect January 1, 2011. We will be required to publish to all residents the meeting schedule for the Board and Neighborhood Rep Meetings. Both meetings will be open to all owners to attend. If they have something they want to discuss, they must notify Glenda or Jim ahead of time so it can be added to the agenda.

The neighborhood reps were given a copy of the schedules tonight and a copy will be mailed to all residents with their dues statements so they are aware of the schedule for 2011.

Dean reports that currently there are 1074 homes in Cedar Creek. In the past 12 months 30 new and 36 resale homes have been sold. It is time to publish the Cedar Creek HOA Manual and Directory. These will be supplied in new binder. Please make sure you read through the HOA portion and general information as there have been some changes and updates that you will want to know about. The directory will be provided alphabetical and street address.

Communications – This year we are moving to a quarterly publication. It will be in a slightly different format. If you have input or would like to provide news article please send your information to: cedarcreaker@yahoo.com.

eNeighbor – There is approximately 58% of the homes registered on eNeighbor at this time. We would like to see the majority of the homes registered as it is an excellent source for information. This is also a source for the HOA to notify residents of

happenings or changes in the community. Steve Maerz is the administrator for this site.

Please remember that the Market is now open and is looking for our support.

S&R Committee – Matt McLane

The S&R pool was renovated this year so we are now turning our focus on the SG Pool for 2011. Repairs and improvements need to be made not just to the pool but also the play area. We are going to have an engineer look at this area and give us some ideas of what might be done to improve the area over all. This does not mean there will be major reconstruction to the pool, just repairs. We will be ordering new furniture and looking to see what can be done to improve the play area.

The New Rep Orientation Meeting will be held January 19th, 2011 at 6:00 p.m.

A. It was three to one against.

Cedar Creek Landscapes In 2011

Turf Design graciously accepts the opportunity to provide lawn and landscape services to the Cedar Creek community. All of us at Turf Design extend our best wishes for a prosperous year filled with health and happiness.

I expect great success with the team of qualified individuals that are dedicated to providing landscaping services for Cedar Creek residents. This year, our team assisting in maintaining the landscape to your expectations of quality, and hopefully increase your enjoyment of your community are Lindsey Richardson, Kevin Pike, and Dave Peters. Lindsey, with a Master's Degree in Landscape Architecture from Kansas State University, will be assisting in quality control including overseeing the ornamental crews. Kevin will continue to supervise mowing crews, assist in general land management projects, and is a Kansas Certified Commercial Pesticide Applicator. Dave brings five years' experience as a chemical applicator for residential and commercial properties and will be supervising the residential chemical applications. In addition, Turf Design has several individuals on staff that help support our services such as Rick Summit, Irrigation Specialist with over 10 years of irrigation experience and Nicole Marshall, Landscape Designer with a Master's in Landscape Architecture from the Rhode Island School of Design. Our administrative staff includes Julie Heavin, Bekah Phillips, and Cari Kelly, Executive Office Manager.

Turf Design service packages will be available to all neighborhood representatives at the first Neighborhood Representative Meeting of the year to be held on January 26, 2011. Neighborhood reps will also be receiving a monthly schedule of services including detailed descriptions of work to be completed and a weekly itinerary that will outline the areas to receive services within each neighborhood.

There are also many changes coming to Cedar Creek! In January, Turf Design crews will begin working on the Cedar Creek trail system. Brush will be removed that impedes the walking trails, trash will be removed, and preparation for annual mulching will commence. If you have a chance, please take the opportunity to hike around the 3+ miles of the Shadow Lake Trails and enjoy the winter landscape and wildlife throughout Cedar Creek.

In February, Turf Design crews will begin cutting back ornamental grasses, cleaning-up remaining debris, and pruning certain shrubs and perennials. Tall native areas will be cut to prepare for spring, and as the temperature warms the first round of chemical applications will be completed on the buffalo and fescue turf.

The month of March will bring color to the Cedar Creek landscape. Numerous daffodils have been planted throughout the area for an early spring display. Witchhazel, Forstia, Lenten Rose, and Pulmonaria will also be blooming, and like daffodils are not destroyed by deer browsing. Turf Design crews will also begin mulching ornamental beds and trees as well as applying the first applications of pre-emergent to all ornamental landscape beds throughout Cedar Creek.

Please let us know how we are doing, and if you have a suggestion on improving our services. I am available for contact and would love to hear from you! There are several avenues for communication via phone, email, e-neighbors or through the H.O.A. office.
